Benefits of implementing the AIS "Centralized Accounting for Financial and Business Activities of Budgetary Institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic":



Obtain accurate and timely information on the financial and business activities of a budgetary institution, as well as on the status of its physical assets, by generating financial reports online;



Use accounting procedures to exercise control over the safety and intended use of assets held by a budgetary institution;



Centralized accounting in a single application will allow stricter control over the timeliness, completeness and accuracy of amounts related to both financial and budgetary accounting;



Provide information necessary for the preparation of accounts at all levels of the budgetary system;




Ensure a transparent information environment for recording financial and business activities of the institutions.


Optimize the overall cost of maintaining accounting and human resources services.

Planning for the Future



2024-2026 - Implementation of the system of Centralized Accounting in the Financial and Business Activities of Budgetary Institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic in the general government sector using the UCoA;



2027-2030 – Implementation of the system of Centralized Accounting in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards.









Stages of the Centralized Accounting Implementation

On December 21, 2022, the Ministry of Finance of the Kyrgyz Republic approved the following pilot organizations: State Property Management Fund under the Ministry of Economy and Commerce, Ministry of Agriculture, Ministry of Health, State Customs Service under the Ministry of Finance, State Tax Service under the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Education and Science, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Labor, Social Security and Migration, Bishkek Mayor's Office, Lebedinovsky Aiyl Okmotu;

On June 19-22, 2023, a training on the use of the UCoA in accounting was held for employees of ministries and agencies;




On September 11-15, 2023, a training on the use of the UCoA in accounting was held for the territorial departments of the Ministry of Finance;



After December 2023, online trainings were held for all budgetary institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic.



On January 8, 2024, the system of Centralized Accounting in Financial and Business Activities of Budgetary Institutions of the Kyrgyz Republic was launched
