




# T&C programme 2007-2010





# T&C (&T) legal framework fully established






# Programme Council

- Development of professionalism in the IA profession – PIFC strategy 2009-2011
- New body - CHU advisory body
  - 7 members + secretary
  - Charter on functioning, main functions:
    - Give recommendations on IA T&C Programme and legal framework (content and structure of modules, T&C procedure, materials)
    - Give recommendations on trainers
    - Evaluates training through quality of materials and work of trainers
    - Follow the results of evaluation and make recommendations for further improvement

# Certified Internal Auditors (CPIA) today

- Fully PEM-PAL aligned
- Meeting Croatian EU accession obligations
  - EU funds audit capable (IPA accredited – DIS, EDIS, preparation for Structural and Cohesion funds self assessment preparation ongoing)
- Recognized as profession through structure of public sector
- Certificate accepted in the private sector IA
- 16th generation planed to be trained



# Further challenges and ongoing work

- Retention of internal auditors in the public sector
- Further guidance development
  - New textbook about public sector internal audit
  - Manual for EU funds internal audit
- Further professional development
  - Common body of Knowledge → Training needs assessment → Training Catalogue for CPE
