

- 3,000,000,000 MB of stored data equals 5 B books with 500 pages each
  - **270,000,000** IT cost savings for the federal government since 2008
  - **100,000,000** Pages printed per year
    - **30,000,000** Releases per year for tax office or judiciary
      - **8,000,000** Users of services such as FinanzOnline and HELP.gv.at
        - **30,000** Supervised IT work stations
          - **4,000** Servers
          - **1,150** BRZ experts
            - **400** Applications such as federal budget accounting and ELAK
              - **60** Internationally certified project managers
                - 1 N°1 federal computing centre in Austria





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
