#### **Dynamics of the Open Budget Index** Dynamics of Open Budget Index for Russia in 2006 - 2020 . Russia improved its index from 60 out of 100 points in 2010 up to 74 points in 60 2012 and took the 10th place among 100 examined countries with the average 50 40 index of 43 points out of 100 (and it has 30 been repeatedly noted in Open Budget Surveys of carried out by International Budget Partnership).

✓ As a result, in accordance with the survey methodology, in 2012 Russia was included in a group of countries that "significant amounts present information on the budgetary process for the general public".

# Measures aimed at improving the rating of Russia in terms of the Open Budget Index over the medium term

The strategic goal of the government program of the Russian Federation "Public Finance Management and Regulation of Financial Markets" is to reach 85 % of the value of the Open Budget Index at 85% by 2020.

The Russian Federation will become a member of the group of countries which "provide extensive information to citizens on the budget" (comparative data for year 2012 is presented in the table below) when it achieves the Index value of 81.

Assessments of completeness of information are made based on average points obtained on the sub- group of questions from the survey of the "Open Budget Index 2012". The average score between 0-20 (scant or no information); 21-40 (minimal information); 41-60 (some information); 61-80 (significant information); 81 – 100 (extensive information).

### Potential for growth of the Index [1]. The Citizens' Budget

Recommendation of the International Budget Partnership: To prepare and publish the Citizen's Budget.

#### Citizens' Budget

(questions 109-112 of the Open Budget Survey for 2012)

To ensure the highest possible points on questions of the questionnaire the following is needed:

- The Citizens' Budget has to include information 6 on topics (the budgetary process, revenue collection, priority
  expenditures and their allocation, special information on expenditures by sectors and target programs, contact
  information for citizens' feedback, economic forecasts);
- To disseminate the Citizens' Budget in more than three ways (using Internet, billboards, radio, TV, etc.);
- The executive power body has to ensure broad interaction with different target groups of the population for the
  purpose of identifying their needs in order to record them in the citizens' budget;
- The Citizens' Budget has to be published at all four stages of the budgetary process: planning and approving the Law on the Budget, its execution and verification).

#### Potential for growth of the Index [2]. The Mid-Year Review

Recommendation of the International Budget Partnership: To publish the Mid-Year Review.

#### **Mid-Year Review**

(questions 73-76 of the Open Budget Survey for 2012)

To ensure the highest possible points on questions of the questionnaire it is necessary to improve the explanatory note to the report on execution of the federal budget for the 1<sup>st</sup> half year of the current fiscal year in the following areas:

- to supplement the contents with reporting data related to monitoring of implementation of state programs of the Russian Federation for the 1<sup>st</sup> six months;
- To include analysis of the macroeconomic situation based on actual data and materials prepared for elaboration of the semiannual report on execution of the federal budget;
- · to supplement the contents with verified forecast of expenditures and revenues for the whole fiscal year;
- to supplement the contents with the information on economic problems and proposed measures to solve them, and proposals regarding the budget policy;
- to supplement the contents with verified economic forecast for the whole fiscal year prepared based on analysis of
  actual current economic indicators and also based on the updated forecast.
