- Our department has used transaction registration system. The data from this system was incorporated into the data registration module in June of 2010, and practical application of this module started.





Transaction data is registered; transaction number is assigned

Decision is taken which unit the document belongs to Document sent to the respective

If necessary, the paper version of the transaction is made available


Paper version is receved

Paper version passed on to the relevant stakeholder


Advantages of SGB.net module

- Quick and efficient transaction management
- Archives of e-transactions
- Separate processes are integrated
- Link between incoming and outgoing documents
- Interconnection between separate transactions
- Opportunity to study previous transactions with a given document
- Opportunity to prepare transactions on the basis of templates
- Electronic barcodes make data entry easy and convenient
- Electronic and mobile signatures
- Information about the transaction
- Report about the transaction
- Opportunity for citizens to trace transactions
- Access capability to transactions from other localities and distant transaction management

Current status:

- TS 13298 standards are being applied (in process)
- Adaptation to the transactions exchange format of the Ministry of Development (completed)
- Mobile signature (piloted)
- Archive management (completed)

Next goals

- The goal is to transform the system into a data transfer instrument between different applications
 - ➤ For example : Electronic payment order can be transformed into accounting material
 - > When the appropriations transfer text is compiled, transfer operations will also be carried out
