

FINANCING OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION IN THE REPUBLIC OF CROATIA

LAW ON EDUCATION AND CARE IN PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION – resources for financing of public needs in primary and secondary education are provided through:

- national budget,
- budgets of local and regional self-government units
- resources of the founder (when it is another natural or legal entity)
- revenues generated through own business activities and other earmarked revenues
- parents' contribution for special services and activities in schools
- donations and other sources in accordance with the law


PRIMARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION IN THE NATIONAL BUDGET




THE MINISTRY OF SCIENCE, EDUCATION AND YOUTH – **PRIMARY EDUCATION** – **A 579000 – Allocations in the general budget** – salaries and benefits are allocated in the national budget for approx. **44,369** employees in **919**

primary schools

SECONDARY EDUCATION – A – 580000 – Allocations in the general budget, resources for salaries and benefits are allocated for approx. 22,689 employees in 424 secondary schools.










COP – CENTRALIZED PAYROLL
