### Primary, Secondary and High Schools as Spending Units




#### **Central Budget Funds**

(Managed by Treasury)

All schools submit their payment requests to the spending units affiliated with the Ministry of National Education.

Spending Units submits all payment requests to the **Treasury** 



# Parent-Teacher Association Accounts

(Managed Independently)

- Own resources
- Donations or funds by Parents



### **Executing Payments for Spending Units**



#### **Central Budget Funds**

Parent-Teacher Association Accounts

**Schools Submit Their Payment Requests Electronically to (Regional) Spending Units** 

These Accounts are Managed Independently by the Association.

Regional Spending Units Collectively Submit all Requests Electronically to the Treasury.

Treasury meet the demands in the system in line with cash management program and sent the cash to spending unit to make payment to final beneficiary. Spending units do not have right to any change in the amount approved by Treasury.

**Spending Units Collectively Submit all Requests to the Treasury** 

Spending Units Reports all financial Activities to the General Directorates of Accounting on Daily Basis and This Department Publishes all Financial Activities Collectively on Ministries' Website Monthly.

These Accounts are Managed Independently and Accounting and Reporting is Done in the seperate system.
