Together they...

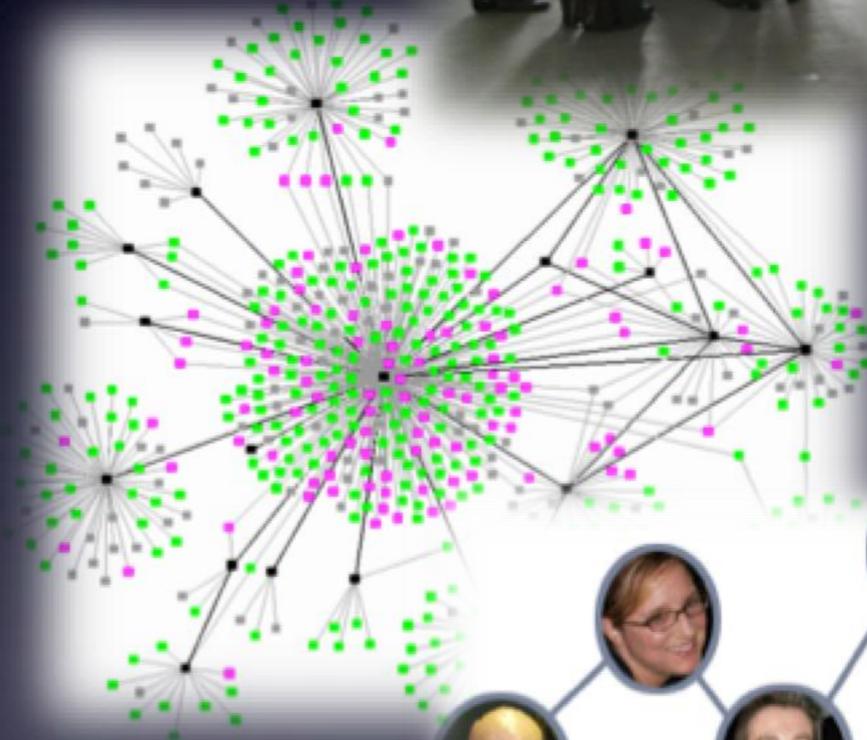
- improve their ability to do what they care about

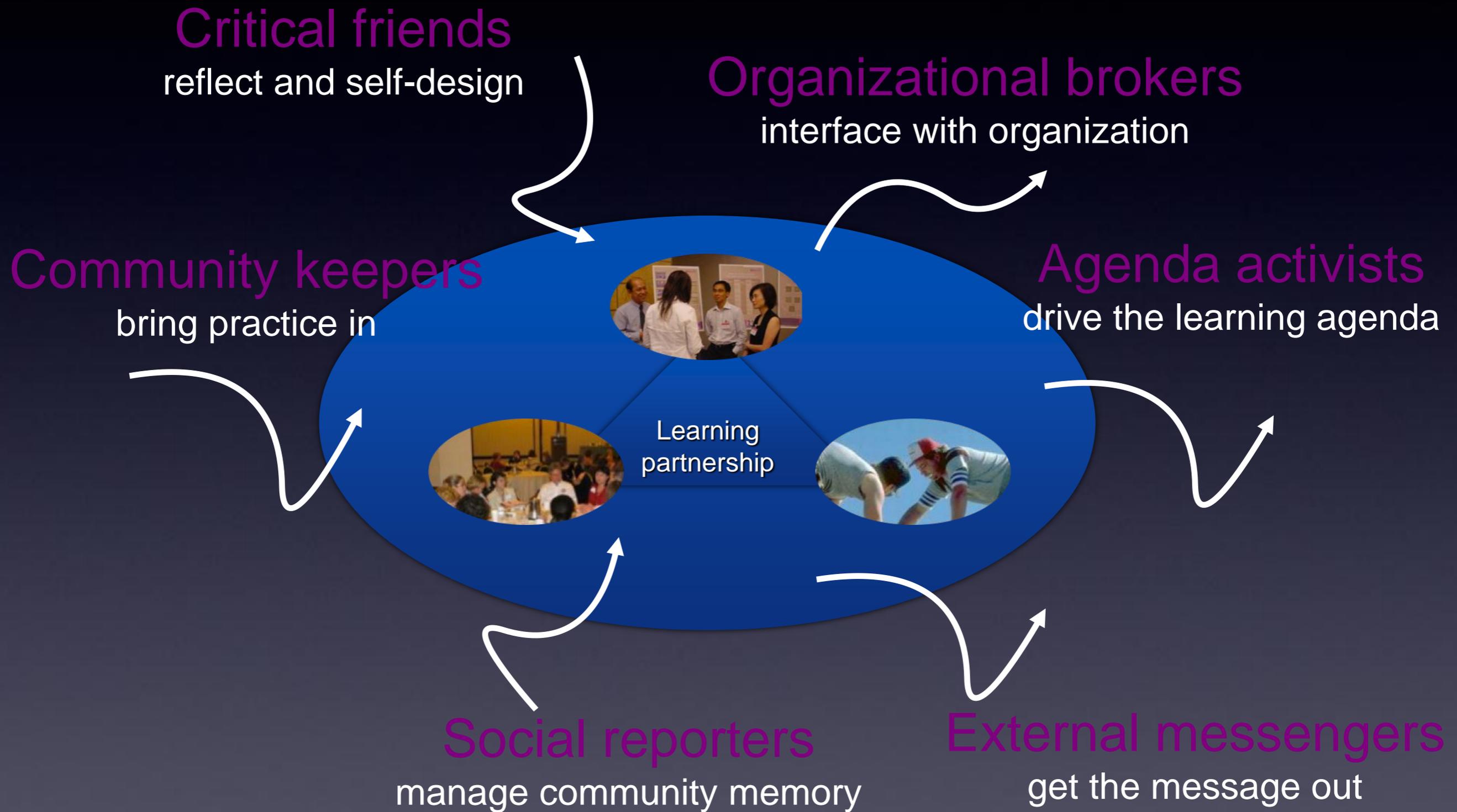

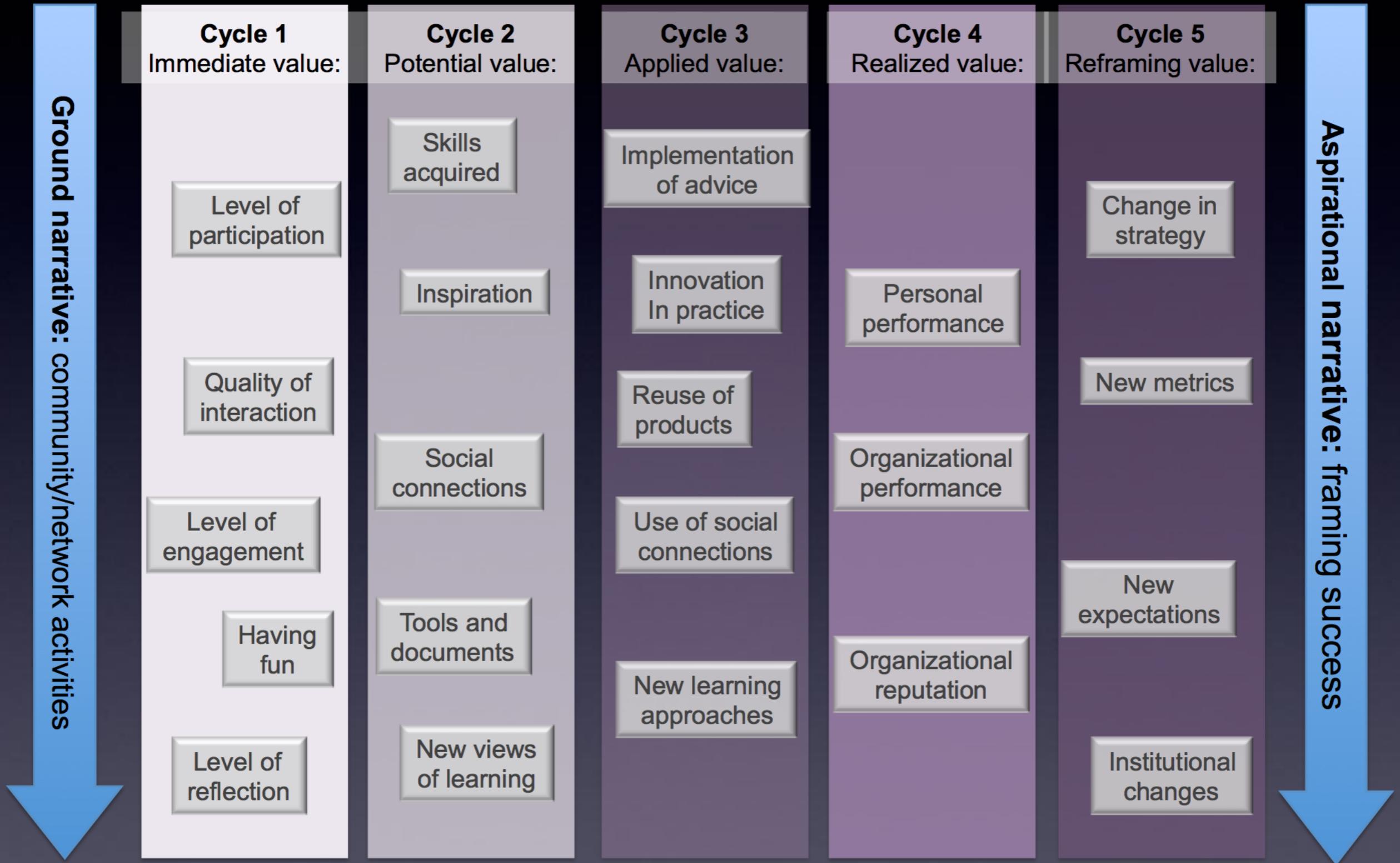

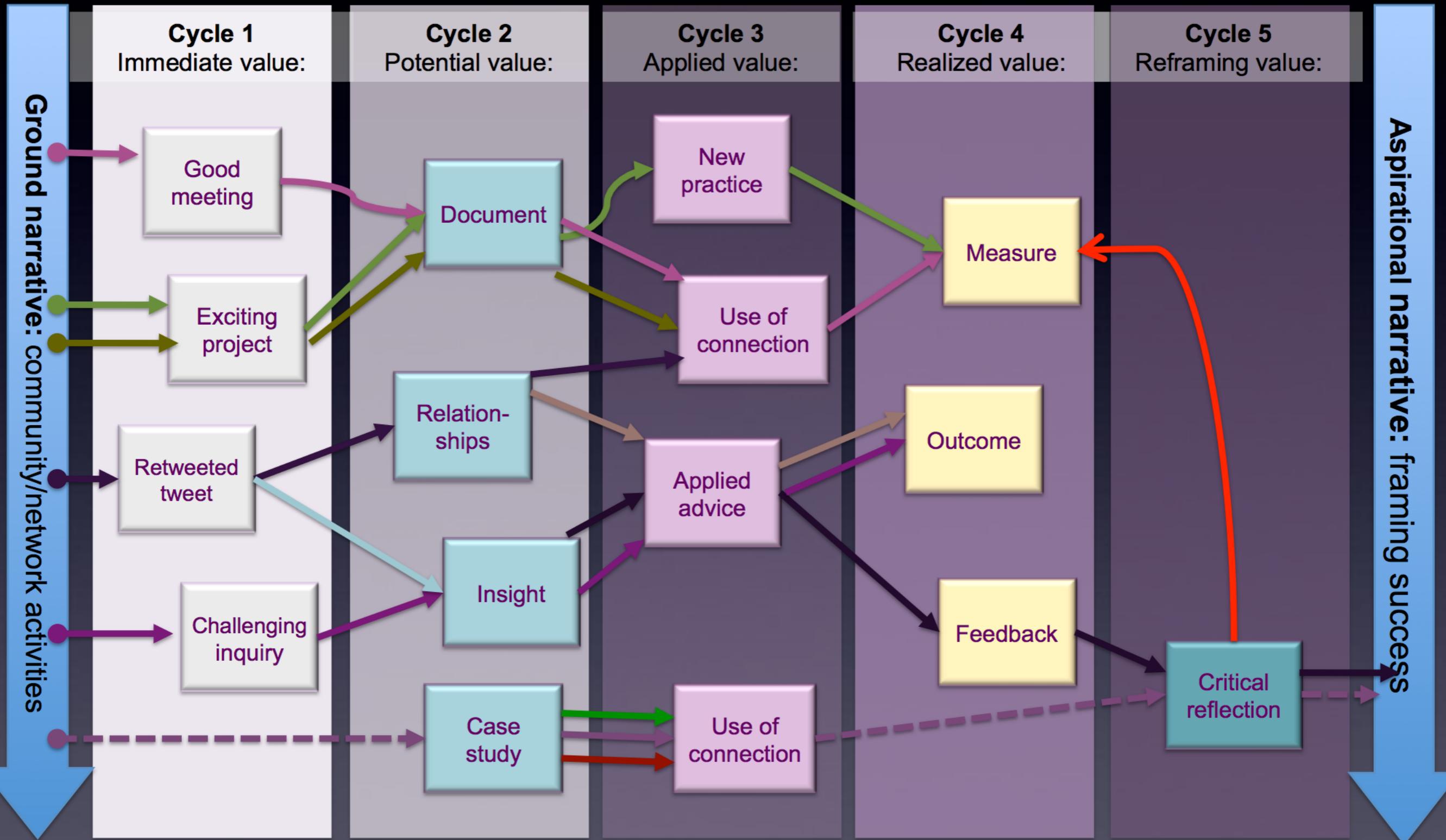

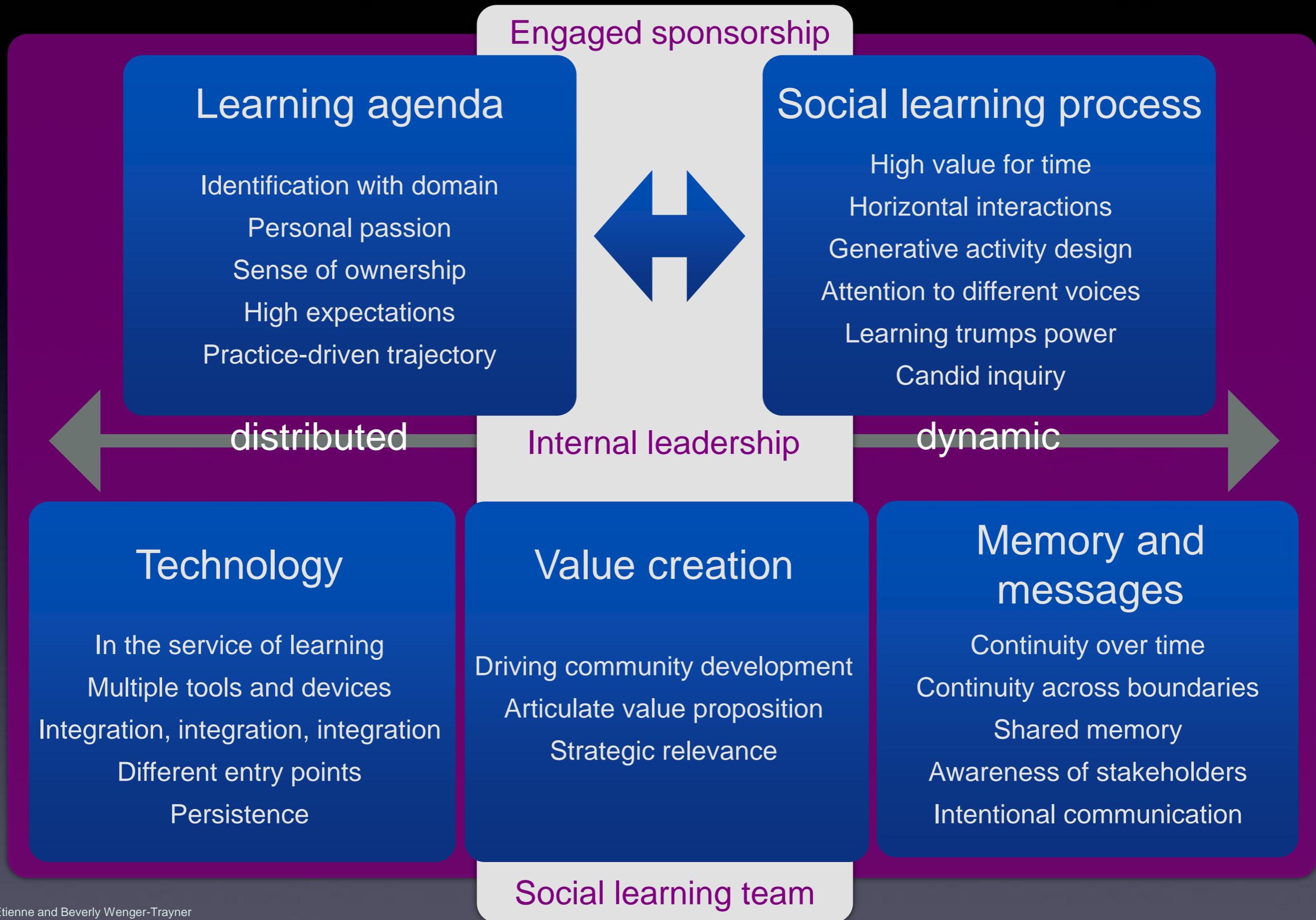
