PEMPAL TCOP SV TO VIENNA FEEDBACK SURVEY

On January 28-30th, 2015, the PEMPAL TCOP representatives study visit to Vienna, Austria took place.

After the event, the on-line survey in two languages was created on the base of the standard set of questions developed by Secretariat. The aim of the survey was to receive event feedback and to learn plans for the future.

The survey started to collect responses on February, 6 and finished on February 13, 2015. Invitations to take part in the survey were sent to all participants of the event. We sent 11 invitations.

7 persons started to response to the survey. From these responses -1 was from the resource persons, 6 — from the representatives of PEMPAL countries.

In this report, we analyze all 7 responses. For further calculation, we take this quantity as 100%.


All these responses will be included in the general Feedback Event Database.

The questionnaire comprises five parts: About the Respondent, Event Delivery, Event Administration, Overall Impression, and Recommendations for the Future. There are a total of 23 questions in the survey.

ABOUT THE RESPONDENT

Q1 You are...
